Importance of cable management

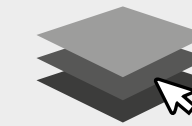
Solar cables often go through a degree of thermal fluctuation where cables expand and contract. Having sufficient cable length is essential for avoiding stress on cables and connectors but also protecting them against abrasive edges and roof surfaces is very important.

The addition of cable care solutions also requires attention for equipotential bonding of metal parts in the system. IEC60364 prescribes that all conductive metal parts in a PV mounting system must be bonded. This prevents potential differences between metal parts, causing electrical shock when these parts are touched simultaneously or possible leakage of current.

For both residential and commercial PV-systems, attention for save and proper cable management is critical. Improper execution can cause a reduced lifespan of cables, followed by potential fire hazards or lower yield.

Material selection

Our ValkCableCare products use a variety of materials to ensure long-lasting performance, including:

- Aluminium
- Zinc-aluminium coated steel
- Zinc-magnesium coated steel
- Hot-dip galvanized steel
- Stainless steel
- Spring steel
- Polypropylene

Our lightweight, strong, and durable aluminium products are ideal for cable basket accessories and micro-inverter clamps. Sawn from large aluminium profiles, they offer excellent corrosion resistance.

Our cable baskets and accessories are made from coated metals: zinc-aluminium for baskets and zinc-magnesium for accessories like covers, clip-on coupling plates, dividers, and PV shelter frames and roofs. Tested (ISO9227) and proven more corrosion-resistant than hot dip galvanized coatings (ISO1461).

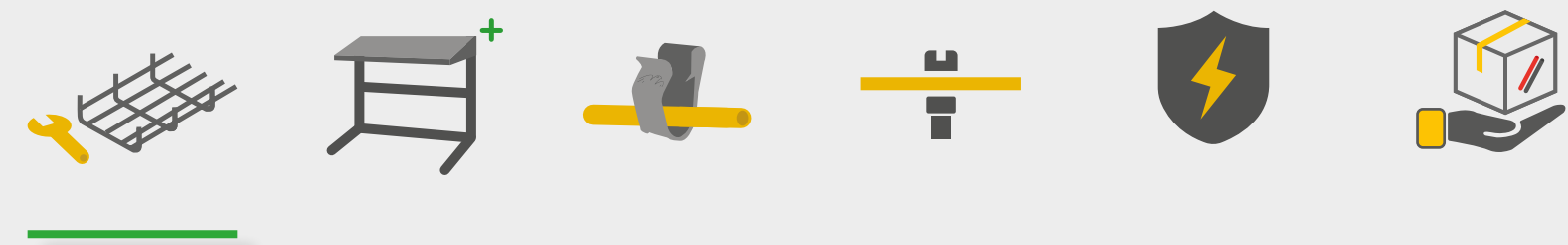
Hot dip galvanized steel products offer excellent corrosion resistance for outdoor applications. Some accessories, such as coupling clamps, coupling plates and mounting brackets, are made from this material. Unlike zinc aluminium and magnesium, post-treatment (e.g., galva-spray) is required after working the metal to maintain corrosion resistance.

Stainless steel and spring steel finds its use in most smaller clamping products like our solar panel and profile clamps, divider clamps and cover clamps. These material are excellent for outdoor use and bears great clamping strength.

Polypropylene is a durable plastic used in many outdoor applications where temperature fluctuations are common. It bears great impact resistance and is incredibly lightweight.

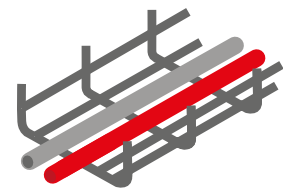


Cable baskets

Our cable baskets are a great solution for safely guiding cables of a PV-installation. We offer a variety of cable baskets with different widths in heights of 60mm and 35mm. We also supply various accessories to further meet the needs of a project.

Fill rate

The temperature of the cable increases as the number of cables in a bundle grows. Therefore, it's important to respect the filling ratio of a cable basket to comply with the NEN1010 standard. Staying within these limits ensures safe and reliable electrical installations.

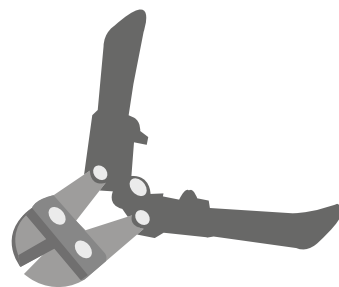

Cutting cable baskets

Besides being lightweight and strong, our cable baskets are also very workable.



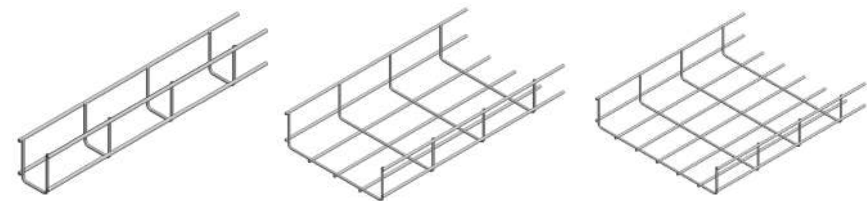
These cable baskets can be easily customized using simple cutting operations. Always use a pincer with an offset cut to minimize the risk of cable damage by cutting close to wire crossings.

Thanks to the zinc-aluminium coating, no post-treatment is needed, saving both labor and time.

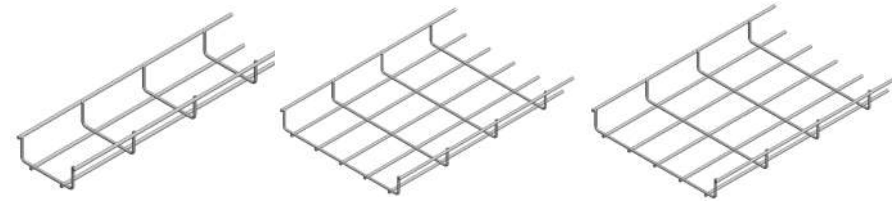
Creating corners, cross sections, T-sections and more can be effectively done using minimal steps. For full instructions or information, use the diagrams found in de appendix.

Cable filling rate of cable baskets

Per EN50618 Table 3, a 6mm² solar cable in open air can carry a maximum current of 70A. The temperature rises with the increase in the number of bundled cables. Table 52.B.17 states that the maximum number of cables in a single bundle is 20 circuits; exceeding this number is not recommended as it falls outside the NEN1010 guidelines.

Experience indicates that cable management is frequently overlooked during planning. Mistakes in cable management can reduce the lifespan of a PV system, create hazardous conditions, and result in increased maintenance expenses.

To safely install cabling it is important to bundle the cables. One should take into account the maximum current each cable can handle in relation to the surrounding temperature.

Filling the cable tray to a maximum of 70% is required to enable the dissipation of heat generated by the bundled cables. The Dutch implementation of the HD-IEC 606364 advises that the PLUS and MIN cables are kept in close proximity to each other to prevent induction loops, while ensuring there is still space between them to avoid flash arcs.

By following the visualized scheme, planning of cable management can become more concrete and done following guidelines for a safe PV-installation.

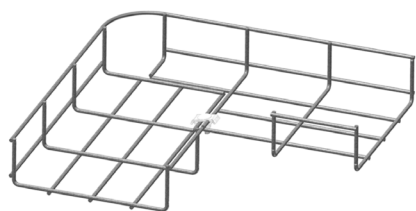
Cutting diagram for cable baskets

Cutting diagram of cable baskets

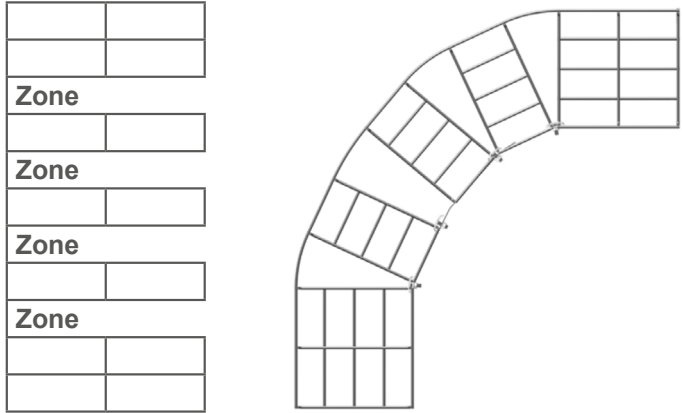

Consult the data provided in the ballast calculations. The data contains the required weight to withstand wind loading for the specified wind zone, basic wind speed and installation height. The results in the calculations are based on a combination of theoretical calculations and practical wind tunnel tests and CFD-analyses to ensure safe installation of our PV Inverter Shelter Double and Mini. Contact Van der Valk Solar Systems for safe ballast calculations.

The combined weight of the PV shelter, inverter, and additional load must be equal to or exceed the data used and specified in the calculation.

Before installing a PV Inverter Shelter Double or Mini on a roof surface, it is necessary to carry out a thorough inspection to verify that the roof structure is capable of supporting the required load.

If the inspection shows that the roof structure or wall cannot support the required load. Contact Van der Valk Solar Systems for an appropriate solution for your project.

Design the roof layout and install the shelter according to the installation instructions.

After installation, regularly inspect and maintain the solar shelter to ensure they remain within safe limits, especially in regions prone to extreme weather conditions.

Maintain records of the wind speed data, exposure category, and calculations used for your specific installation. This documentation can be valuable for compliance purposes and future reference.

By following these steps and consulting the calculation, you can ensure the safe and effective installation of the PV Inverter Shelter Double or Mini in outdoor environments with varying wind conditions.
